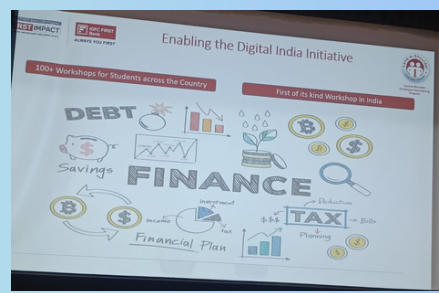
IMPRESSIVE WIN AT CBSE NORTH ZONE 2 TAEKWONDO CHAMPIONSHIP
