


A STRONG SUPPORT STAFF IS THE BACKBONE OF ANY ORGANISATION

An educational visit to IIWBR proved to be a valuable and enriching experience for Medical Stream students of Grades XI and XII. By engaging in hands-on training in DNA extraction, PCR amplification and apparatus handling, students gained practical insights into the world of Molecular Research. The brochures on good agricultural practices were distributed to the students which broadened their understanding of the interplay between Scientific Research and Food Production. The visit facilitated a holistic learning experience, encouraging students to recognize the importance of interdisciplinary knowledge and its potential impact on global issues.



A two day educational tour to BML Munjal University, Indian School of Hospitality and Hero MotoCorp Plant, Gurugram was conducted to acquaint the students with various course options available in the leading institutes and their educational culture. 51 students of Grade XII from all the Streams grabbed the opportunity.
