## NURTURING FUTURE LEADERS: INVESTITURE CEREMONY 2025



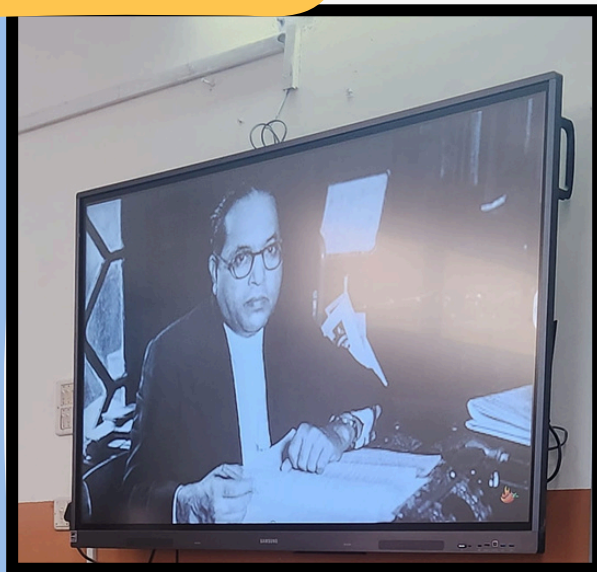

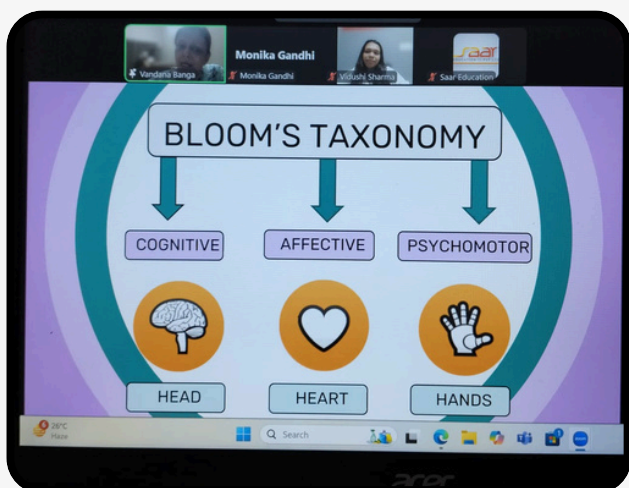
## ACHIEVEMENT IN SILVER ZONE G.K. OLYMPIAD (2024-25)

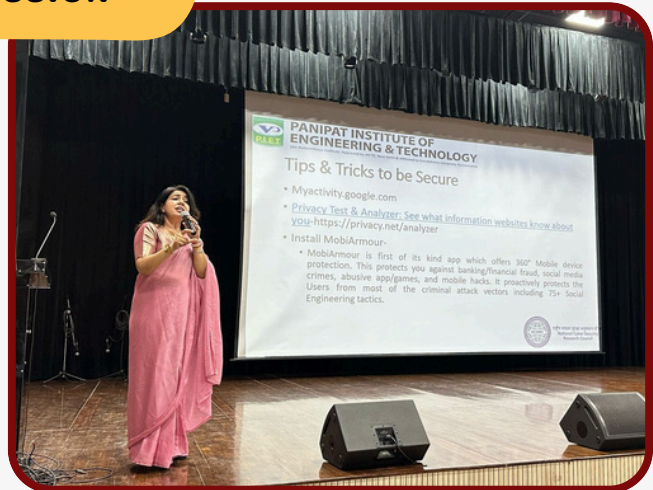
## TURNING PAGES, OPENING MINDS – WORLD BOOK DAY CELEBRATED WITH ENTHUSIASM
