Together, let us guide our children with wisdom, empathy and hope.

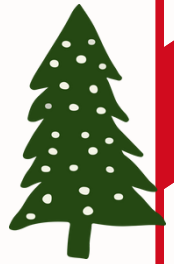

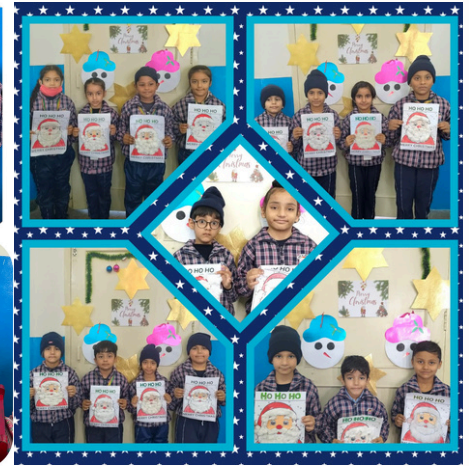
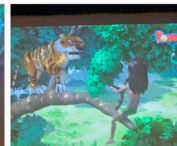
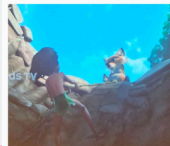
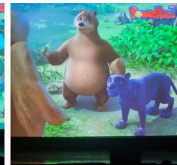


MOVIE SCREENING: PIL'S ADVENTURE

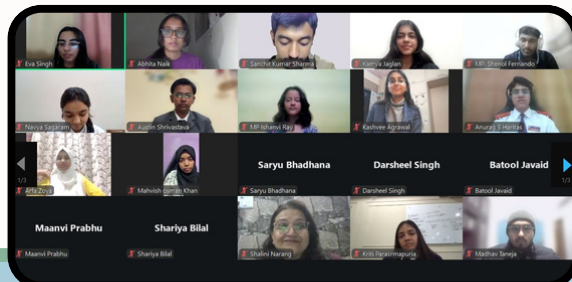
HINDI DEBATE COMPETITION
